SOUNDPOINTS



Soundpoints (or contact points) are like parallel road lanes on which the bow may travel. Students must deliberately choose a particular soundpoint depending on the sonority, character, and expressiveness of the emotions they want to convey.

Begin exploring this concept by practicing the recommended soundpoints in each etude. These are marked with **circled numbers**.





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
